




## Mission and Objective

## Call to Action

- Children with visual disabilities have tremendous potential, but they need the right education and support to realize it.
- Parents caring for a child affected by a rare disease have unmet needs, the origins of which are complex and varied. Our aim to build supportive/therapy care groups for parents caring for a child with an ophthalmological rare disease.
- There is a general lack of programs to provide teachers with the specialized training required for teaching children with visual impairments => we aim to build programs for awareness in schools and universities
